

THE LAYING OF HANDS

Following ancient custom, Bishop Curtin lays hands on Vijay, Samson and Viknesh invoking the Holy Spirit and praying for them in silence for a short period.

THE PRAYER OF CONSECRATION

Bishop Curtin prays aloud the prayer of consecration over Vijay, Samson and Viknesh. It is this prayer, together with the laying on of hands, that constitute the essential elements of the Sacrament of Ordination. Following this prayer, Vijay, Samson and Viknesh will be deacons.

THE INVESTITURE WITH STOLE AND DALMATIC

Vijay, Samson and Viknesh now ordained deacons, are assisted by their friends and representatives from the priests as they put on the stole and dalmatic, the vestments proper to deacons.

PRESENTATION OF GOSPELS AND PEACH

The Bishop is handed the Book of the Gospels by MC. The Bishop places the Book of the Gospels in the hands of each newly ordained and pray.

KISS OF PEACE

The Bishop greets Vijay, Samson and Viknesh with the fraternal greeting "peace be with you."

THE NICENE CREED

I believe in one God, the Father almighty,
